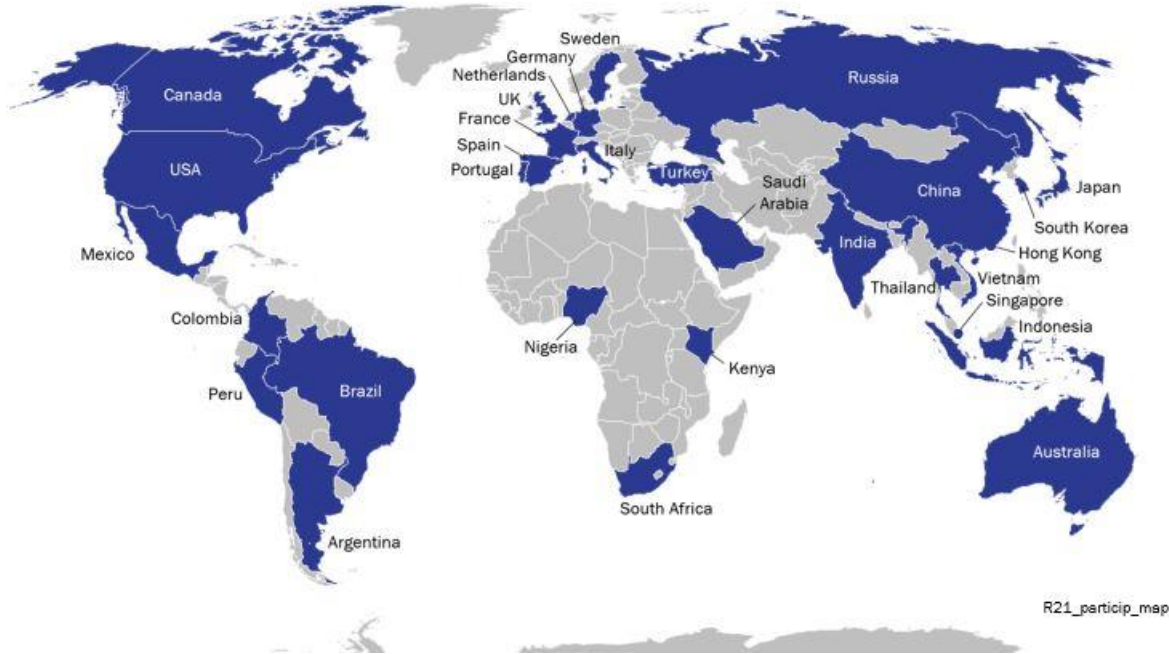

Participating Countries 2021

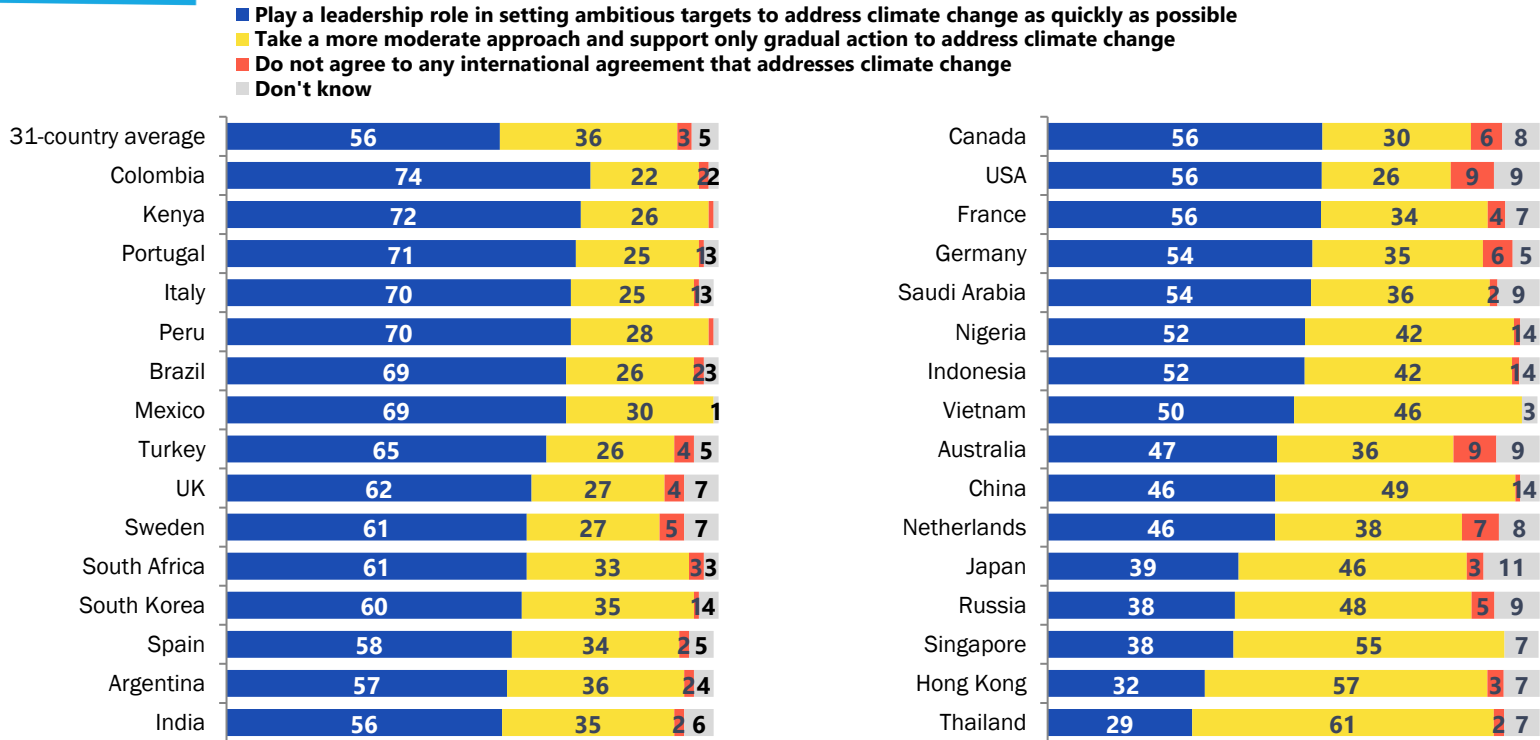


- Representative online samples of approximately 1,000 adults in each of 31 countries and territories (500 each in Hong Kong and Singapore) ($n=30,352$)
- Samples representative of online population, weighted to reflect general population census data
- Online surveying in June and July 2021
- Where historical data are shown, questions were asked using an in-person and telephone methodology before 2019.

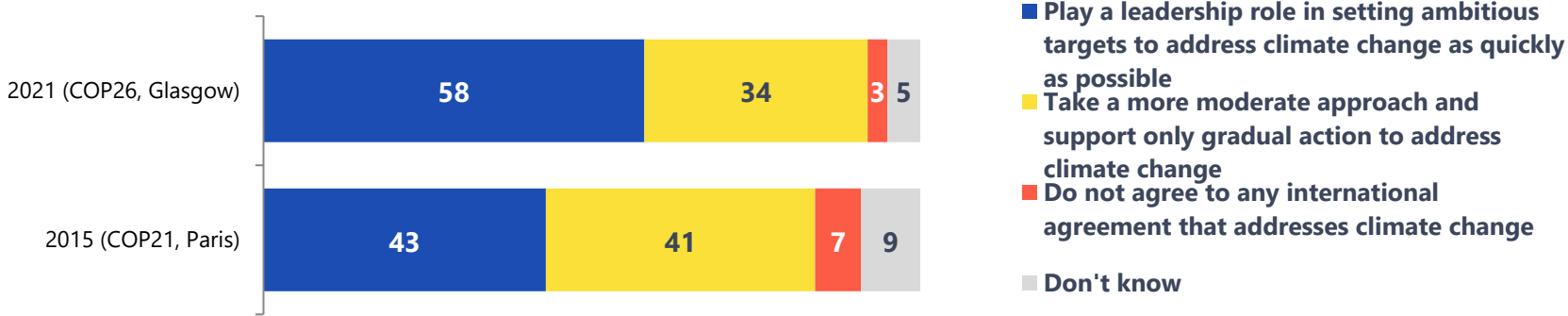

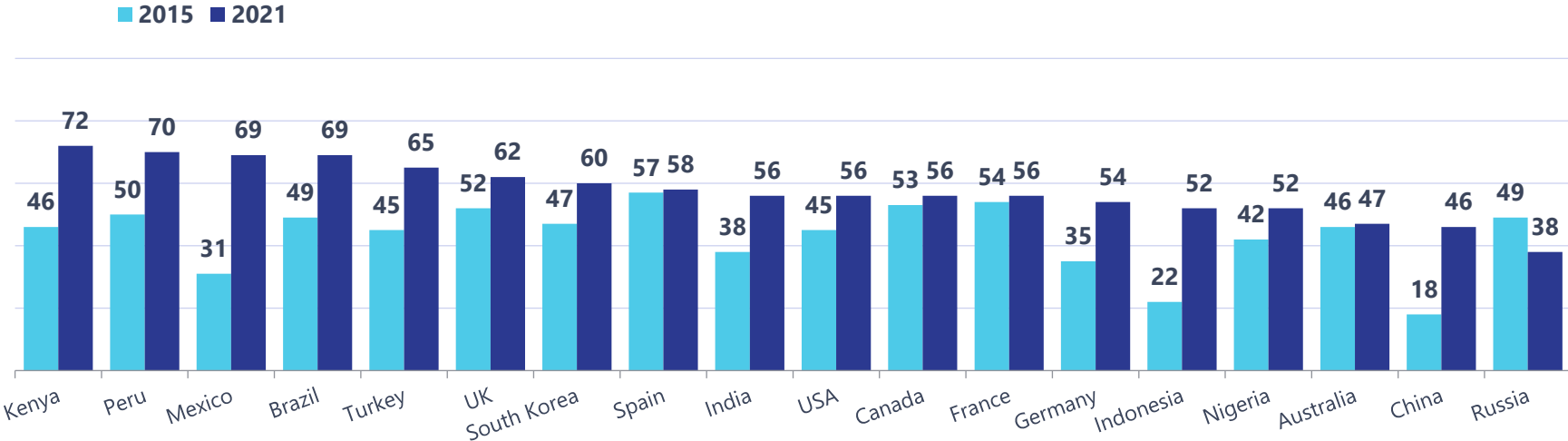

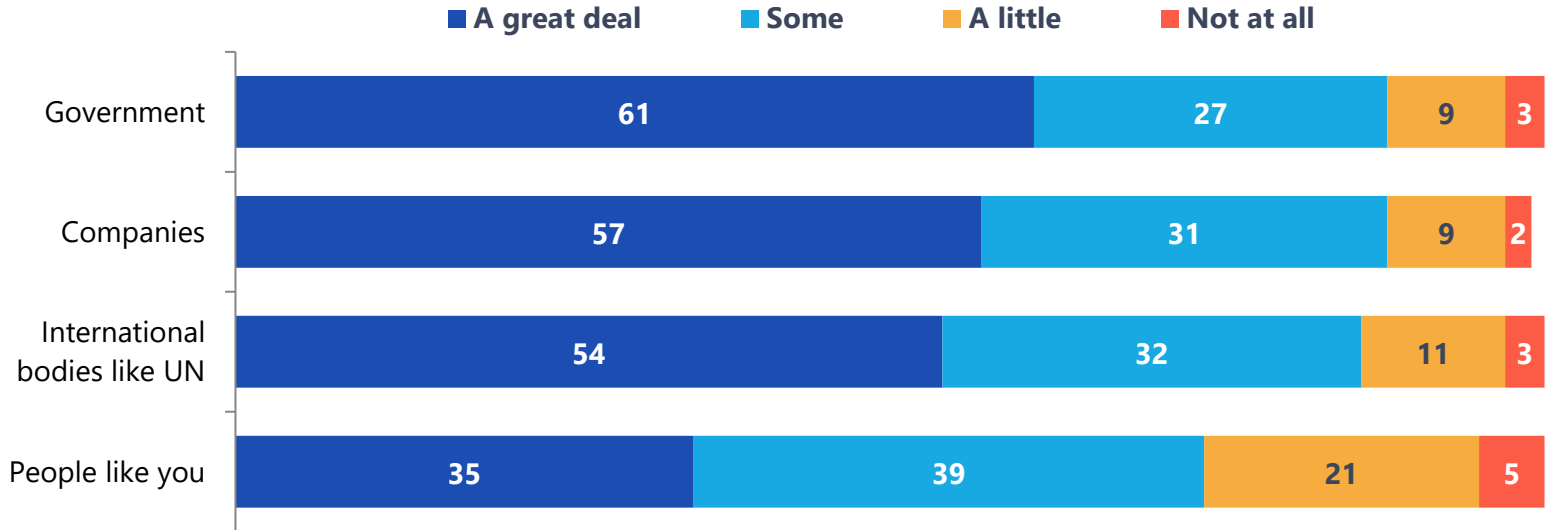

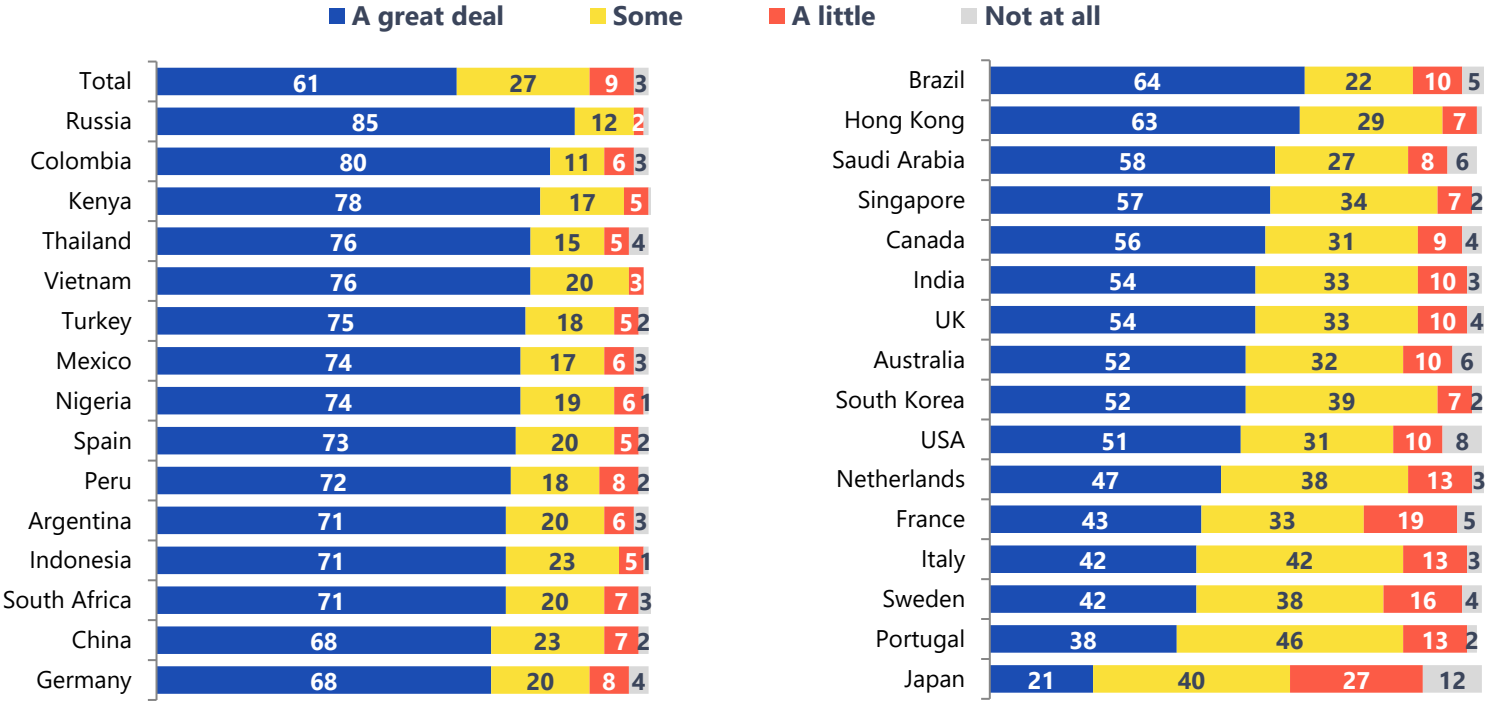

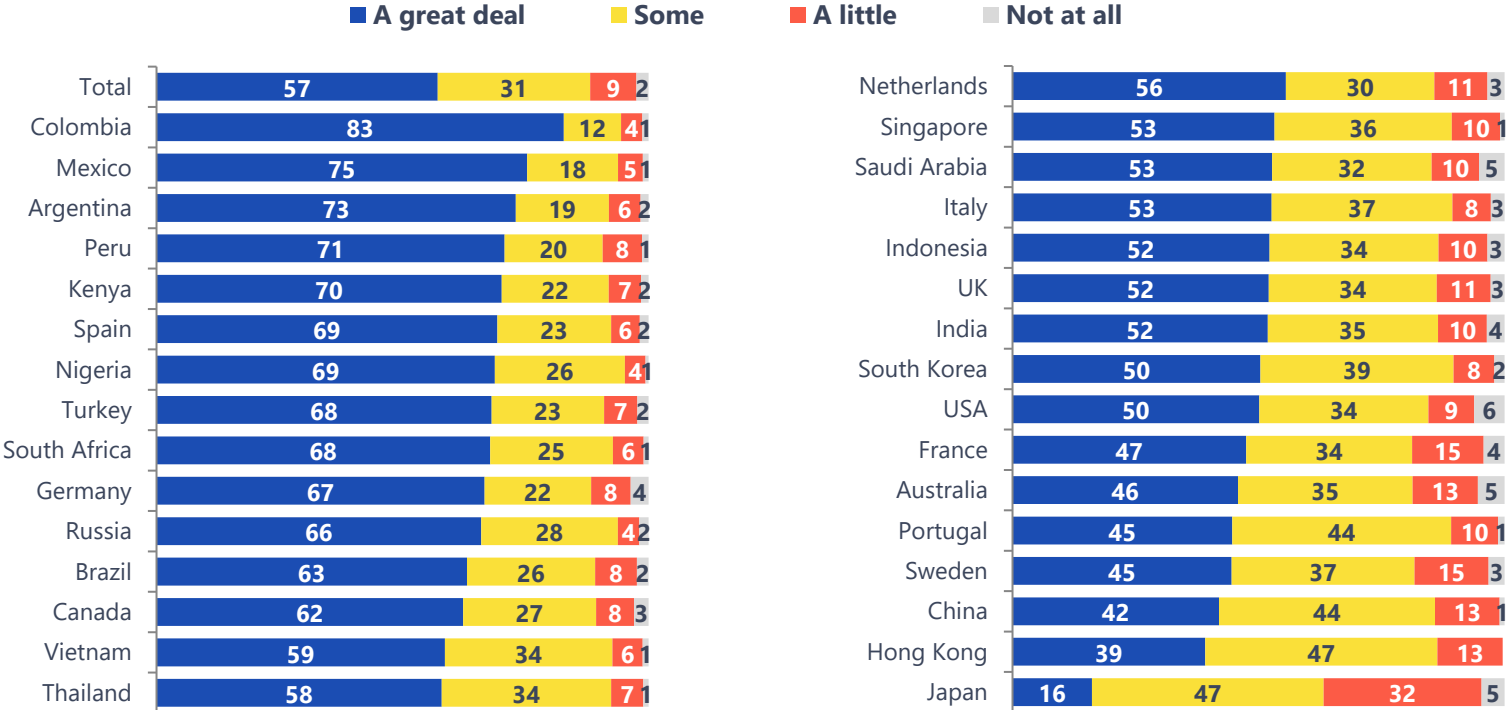

Government, by Country, 2021



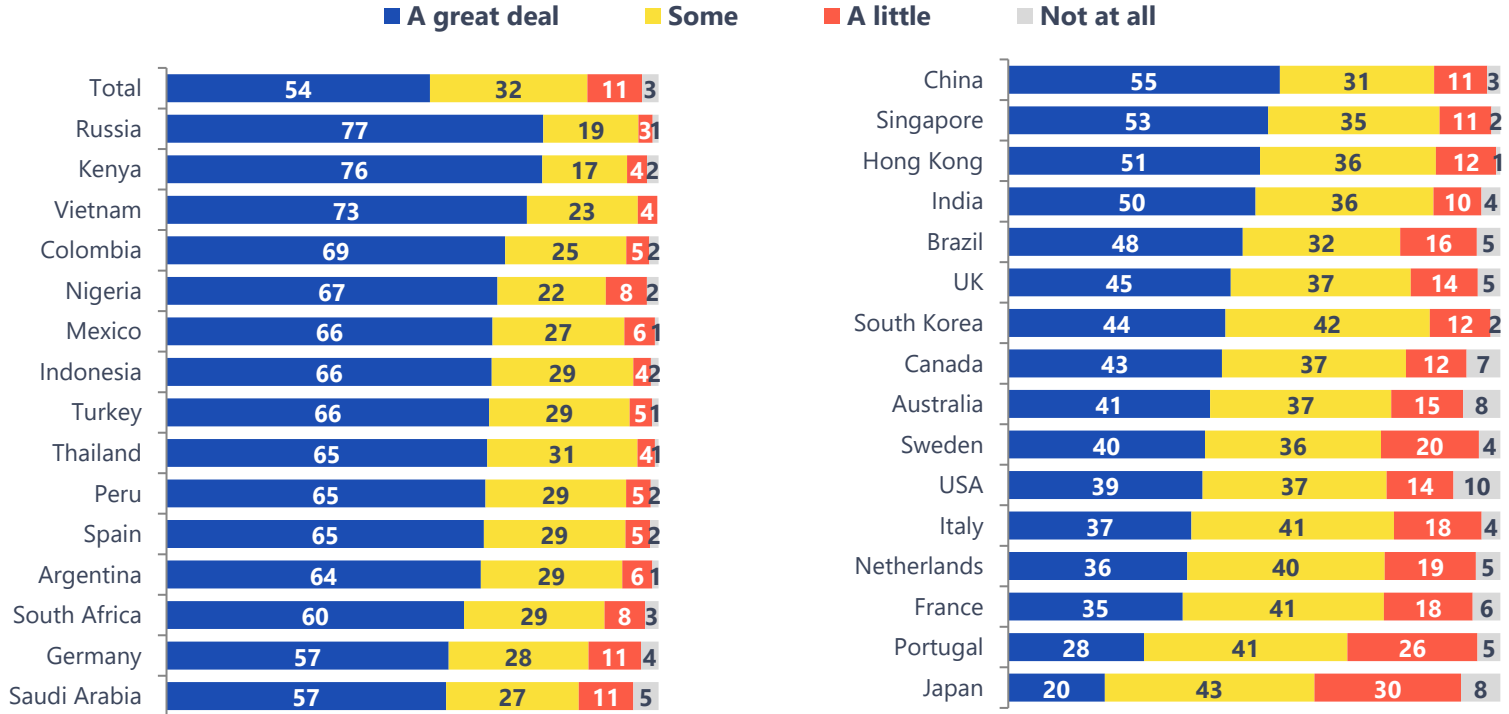

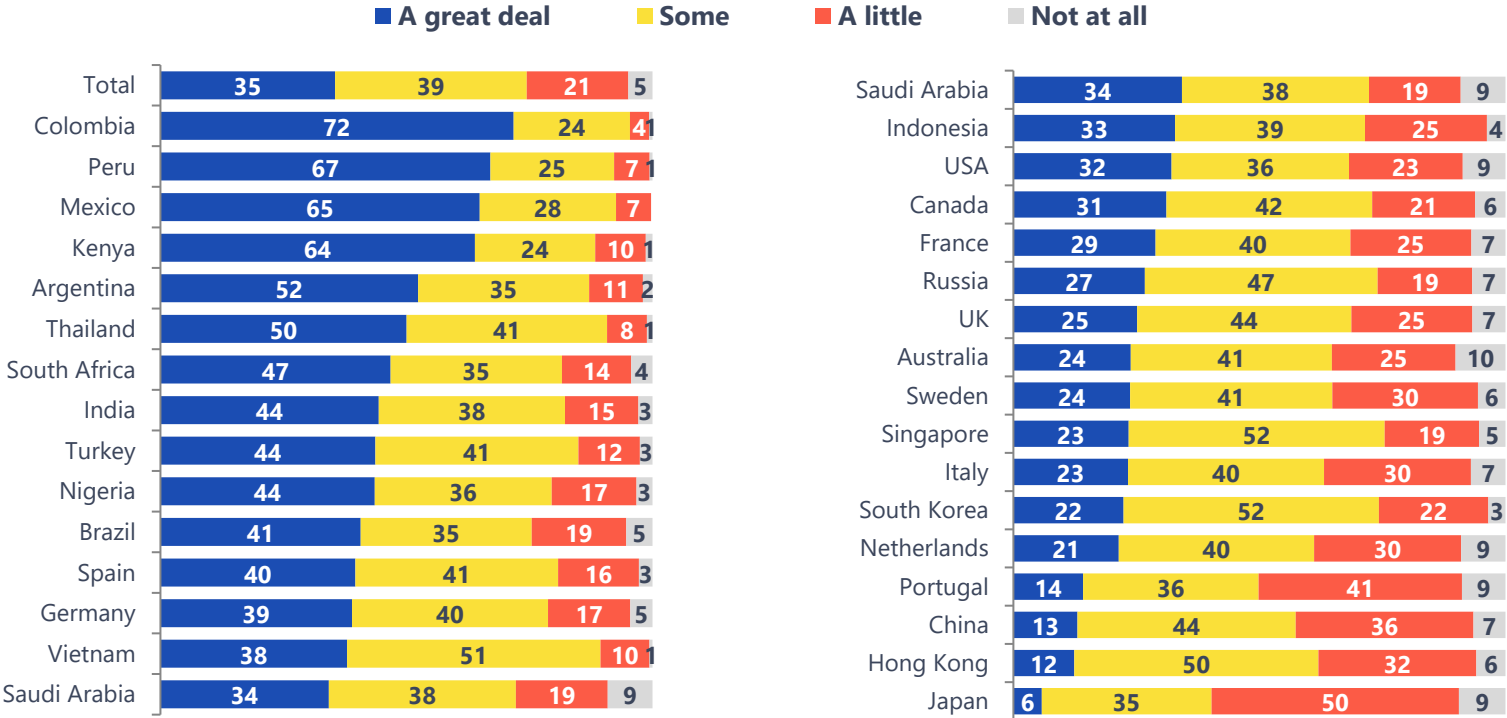

International Bodies Like the UN, by Country, 2021



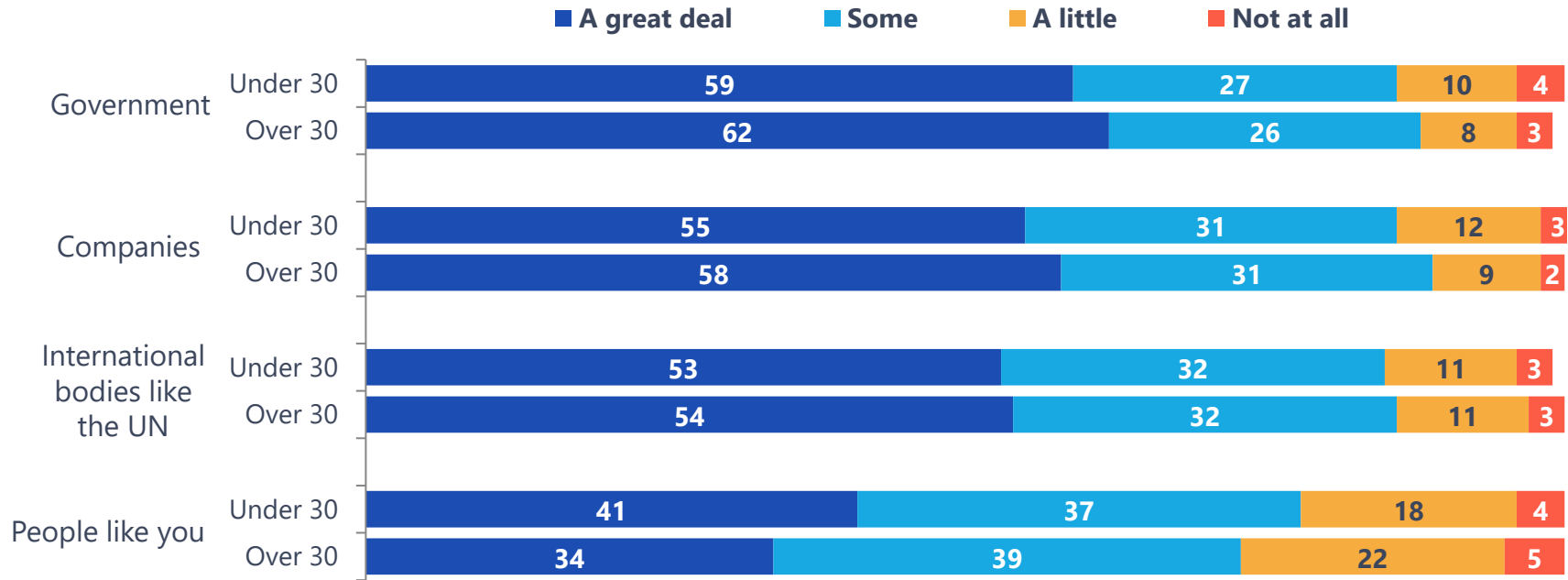

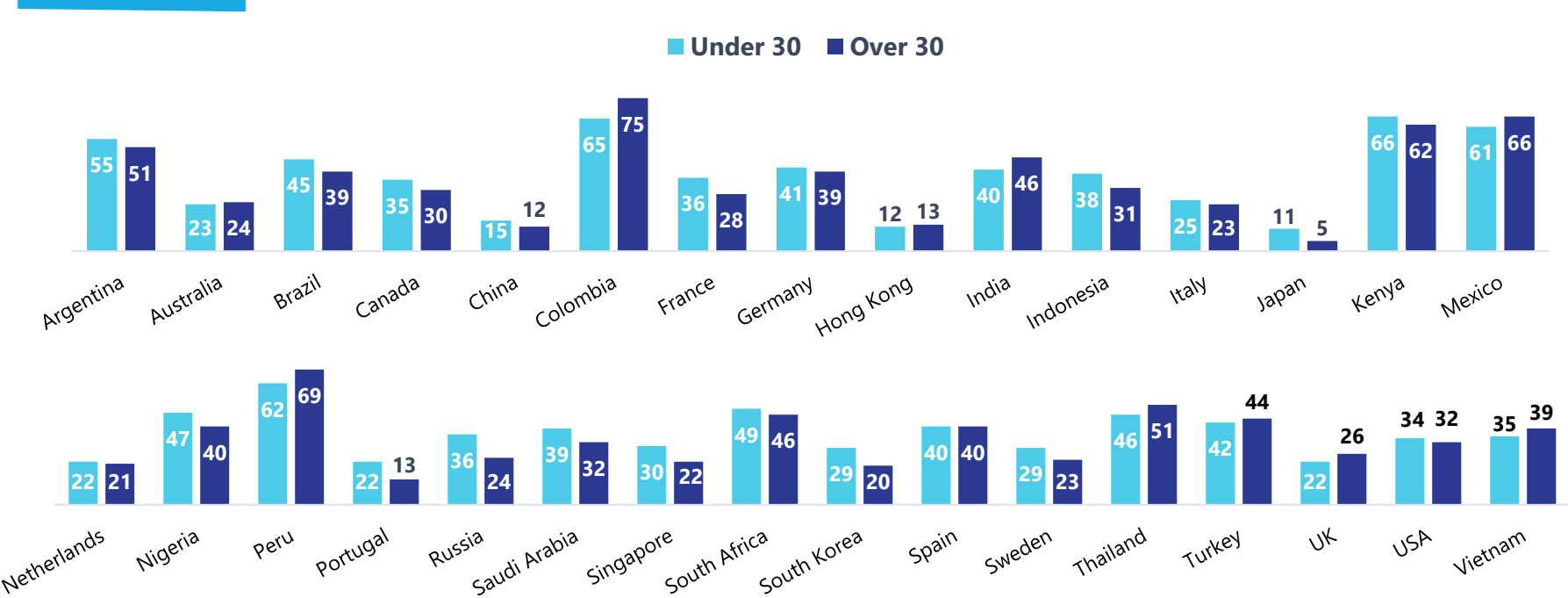

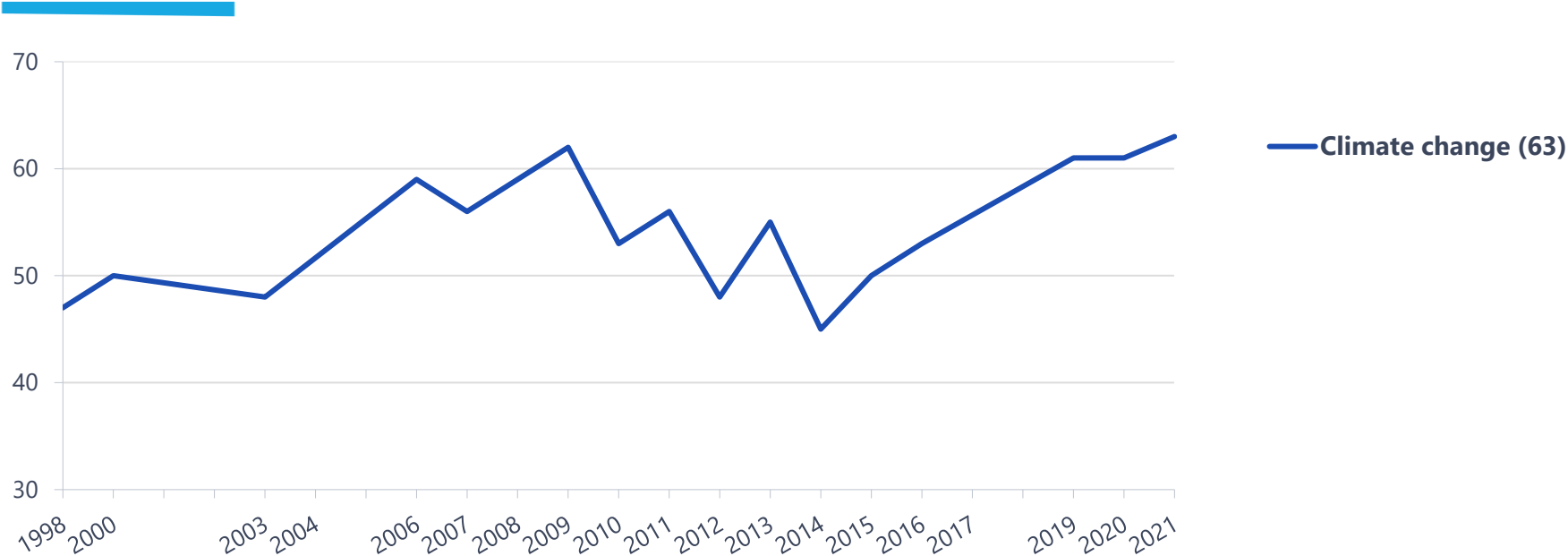
"A Great Deal," People Like Me, under 30 vs over 30, by Country, 2021

Seriousness of Climate Change "Very Serious," Average of 17 Countries,* 1998–2021

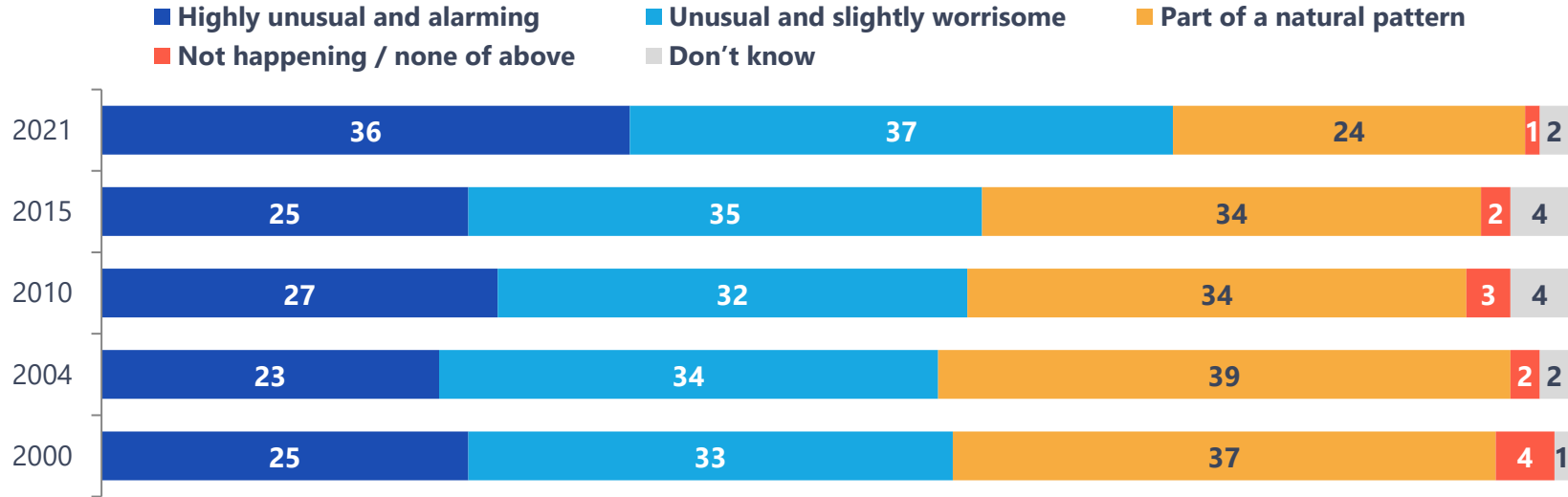

View of Extreme Weather Patterns in Past Few Years

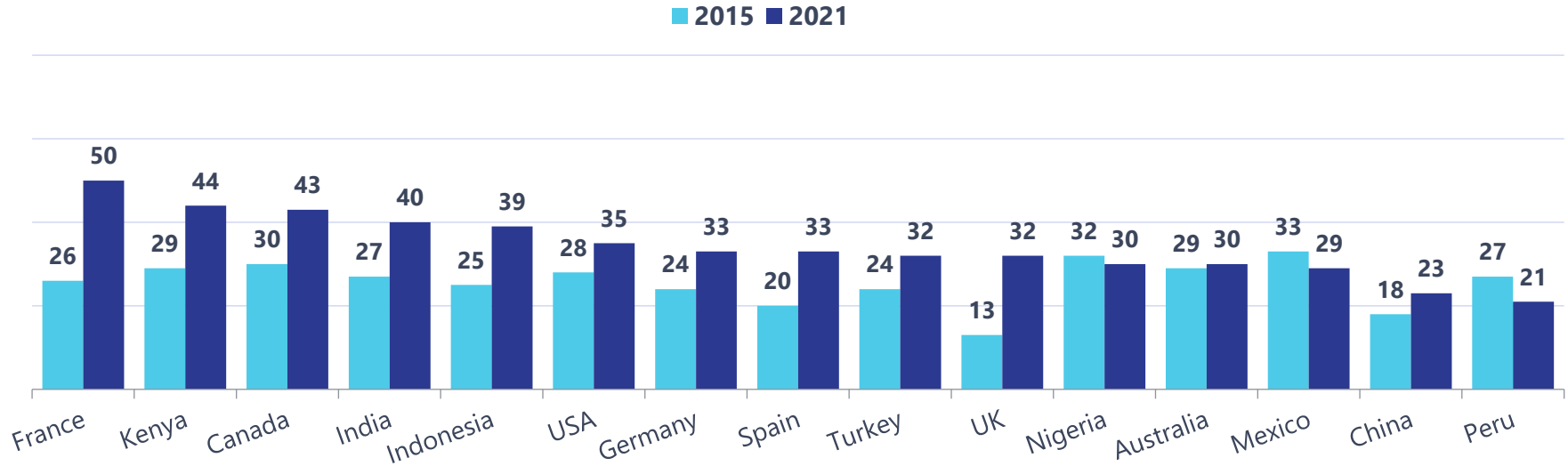
